### COMPLAINT FOR VIOLATIONS OF CIVIL RIGHTS AND OTHER RELIEF

NOW COMES the Plaintiff, LOERNZO RODRIGUEZ, by and through their attorney, Keevan D. Morgan & Bley, Ltd., and complaining of the Defendants, the CITY OF HIGHLAND PARK, DANIEL PIERCE, DAVID LIMARDI, DANIEL J. DAHLBERG, and JERRY CAMERON, and bring this action for violations of their civil rights under the United States Constitution and the Civil Rights Act, 42 U.S.C. §§ 1983.

## JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- A. This Court has jurisdiction to hear this cause by virtue of (a) 28 U.S.C. § 1331, (b) 28 U.S.C. § 1343, (c) 28 U.S.C. § 2201, and (d) 42 U.S.C. §§ 1983.
- B. Venue lies in this District pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1391(b), because one or more of the Defendants reside in this District, and because a substantial part of the events or omissions giving rise to the claim occurred in this District.

#### **PARTIES**

#### The Plaintiff

1. The Plaintiff is a citizen of Mexico who resides in this District.



#### The Defendants

- 2. All the individual Defendants are citizens of the State of Illinois, and reside in this District.
- 3. Defendant CITY OF HIGHLAND PARK is an Illinois Municipal Corporation.
- 4. Defendant DANIEL PIERCE is the Mayor of Highland Park.
- 5. Defendant DAVID LIMARDI is the Highland Park City Manager.
- 6. Defendant DANIEL J. DAHLBERG ("Dahlberg") is the current Chief of Police of Highland Park.
  - 7. Defendants JERRY CAMERON is a Highland Park Police Commander.
- 8. For many years prior to, and including the time of the acts complained of herein, the City has had a policy, custom and/or usage with the force of law in Highland Park that encouraged, and/or allowed the "racial profiling" of ethnic and racial minorities, including unlawfully stopping and/or arresting said minorities, and/or treating them less favorably than caucasians during and after arrests. For purposes of this Complaint, "racial profiling" means the widespread police practice of using race as a factor in deciding whom to target for law enforcement; racial profiling occurs whenever police routinely use race as a negative signal that causes an officer to react with suspicion; racial profiling occurs when a police officer stops, questions, or arrests, or treats someone less favorably on the basis of race or ethnicity. The racial profiling policy was direct, but unwritten, and known as the "NUT Ordinance," meaning, in part, that no "Niggers" were allowed "Up-Town," for all or some of the period complained of.
- 9. Defendant Dahlberg helped to enforce the "NUT Ordinance" when he was a Patrol Officer, and continued it in effect, at least among some Patrol Officers, after he became Chief. In addition, all of the Defendants allowed to continue, without protest or punishment, the encouragement and
