[Docket no. 191]. As explained in the Court's order, the preliminary injunction preserves the status quo. Only those portions of SB 4 that, on their face, are preempted by federal law and violate the United States Constitution are being enjoined. A stay would alter the status quo and allow the entirety of SB 4 to be implemented and enforced on September 1 despite prior findings of preemption and unconstitutionality. Defendants have not met their burden that the Court considers in deciding whether to grant a stay pending appeal: "(1) whether the stay applicant has made a strong showing that he is likely to succeed on the merits; (2) whether the applicant will be irreparably injured absent a stay; (3) whether issuance of the stay will substantially injure the other parties interested in the proceedings and (4) where the public interest lies." <i>Planned Parenthood of Great Tex. Surgical Health Servs. v. Abbott</i> , 734 F.3d 406, 410 (5th Cir. 2013). "A stay is not a matter of right, even if irreparable injury might otherwise result to [Defendants]." <i>Id.</i> Defendants merely repeat the same arguments they made in opposition to the preliminary injunction,

		<p>which the Court has carefully considered and rejected. Defendants have not made a showing (much less a strong showing) that they will likely succeed on the merits. Defendants will not be irreparably injured if the enjoined portions of SB 4 are not implemented and enforced on September 1. While Defendants have an interest in implementing and enforcing their enacted laws, the protection of constitutional rights is paramount. Substantial injury, including constitutional violations, will occur to other interested parties if a stay were to be granted and SB 4, in its entirety, were to be implemented and enforced.
