JUDGMENT

On May 10, 2016, the Court granted Defendant's motion for summary judgment on Plaintiffs' Privacy Act claims and denied the parties' cross-motions for summary judgment on the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") claims. (Dkt. No. 90.) The parties subsequently settled the FOIA claims and stipulated to their dismissal. (Dkt. No. 101.) The Court then granted in part and denied in part Plaintiffs' motion for reconsideration regarding their Privacy Act claims and allowed Plaintiff to bring claims under the Privacy Act based on newly produced documents. (Dkt. No. 111.) The Court having granted Defendant's motion for summary judgment on these remaining Privacy Act claims on January 12, 2018, enters judgment in favor of Defendant and against Plaintiffs.
