ORDER

Pending before the Court is an “Expedited Motion by the American Civil Liberties Union of West Virginia for Leave to Intervene for the Limited Purpose of Seeking to Unseal Court Records.” *ACLU Mot.*, ECF No. 186. By Order dated April 13, 2020, the Court required both parties to submit briefs on the narrow question of the American Civil Liberties Union of West Virginia’s (“Movant’s”) intervention in this matter. Defendants do not dispute that this Court

retains the discretion to permit intervention by Movant pursuant to Rule 24(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, and do not object to the Court exercising that discretion here. *See* ECF No. 191. Consequently, the Court **GRANTS** Movant's Motion, ECF No. 186, and **DIRECTS** the Clerk to send a copy of this Order to counsel of record and any unrepresented parties.
