SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF J. MICHAEL HANNON, ESQ.

On this 6th day of April, 2020, I, J. Michael Hannon, Esq., do hereby declare:

1. This supplemental declaration is based on my personal conversations with officers of the FOP/DOC Labor Committee since April 2, 2020. My observations regarding the provision of medical services to inmates at DOC is based on my experience as general counsel for the FOP/DOC Labor Committee since 2006.

2. Corrections officers at the Jail continue to work without Personal Protective Equipment, to include masks, even though the CDC on April 3, 2020, recommended all persons wear masks when out in public. Although the DOC has represented to the Court that corrections officers are provided face masks, the inventory of PPE filed by DOC with the Court shows there are no masks in its inventory. (Exhibit A, attached). We have confirmed that, with a few exceptions for officers working in the quarantine unit, faces masks are not provided to corrections officers. Those that are provided are kept under lock and key by supervisory officers.

3. On the other hand, at her press conference on April 3, 2020, the Mayor reported that the City has an inventory of PPE designated for “first responders” (including DOC)

consisting of 34,060 face masks, 58,650 pairs of gloves, and 10,346 gowns. (Exhibit B at 9). No explanation is given by DOC or the Mayor as to why this PPE is not being provided to the corrections officers.

4. On April 2, 2020, HANNON LAW GROUP notified the DOC and its attorneys with the Office of the Attorney General that HLG had located a supplier of PPE in Virginia which reports an inventory of PPE available on April 7 of: 23.7 million bottles of hand sanitizer, 50 million surgical masks, 100 million pairs of gloves, 11 million N95 respirators, and 50 million surgical masks. (Exhibit C). The next day, DOC indicated the information was being forwarded to the Office of Contracts and Procurement's vendor vetting team. No further information has been provided as of the date of this declaration whether this supply has been confirmed or ordered.

5. On the morning of April 3, 2020, the DOC announced that inmates will be placed on a modified "lockdown" schedule, with limited time out of their cells. In addition, the DOC for the first time is requiring distancing among inmates in the Jail. (Exhibit D).

6. Also on April 3, 2020, DOC Director Quincy Booth ordered that all DOC corrections officers shall begin 12-hour shifts on Sunday, April 5, 2020. (Exhibit E). During the evening shift on April 5, 2020, the D.C. Jail was understaffed by corrections officers. In the CTF, only one officer was present on each Housing Unit. In CDF, only two officers were present in each Housing Unit. Some officers had to work a second shift because no one relieved them.

7. On April 3, 2020, at 7:33 p.m., the DOC finally sent a response to HANNON LAW GROUP'S March 19, 2020, request for information. (Exhibit F). A review of this letter confirms that DOC does not provide masks and gloves to DOC officers unless they are on a quarantine or COVID positive unit. The contracted cleaning services are only provided in "roll call room, ODRs, locker rooms, and elevators, as well as facilities entrances and the Inmate Reception Center." (Exhibit F at 2). Cleaning on Housing Units continues to be the responsibility of inmates.

8. The Shift Report for Shift 2 on April 5, 2020, for the CDT covers the time period of 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (Exhibit G). The full complement for this shift is 160 officers. Only 74 scheduled officers were available to work. 18 officers were "drafted" to work compulsory overtime, and 15 officers volunteered to work overtime. The total shortfall of officers for this shift was 53.

9. The Log for Shift 2 on April 5, 2020, for CDT notes that at 11:00 a.m. "COVID 19 Sanitation Team Enters the Facility for Cleaning." Then the Log notes at 11:41 a.m. "COVID 19 Sanitation Team Exits the Facility at this Time." (Exhibit G). No other entries indicate any outside sanitization team entering the CDT.

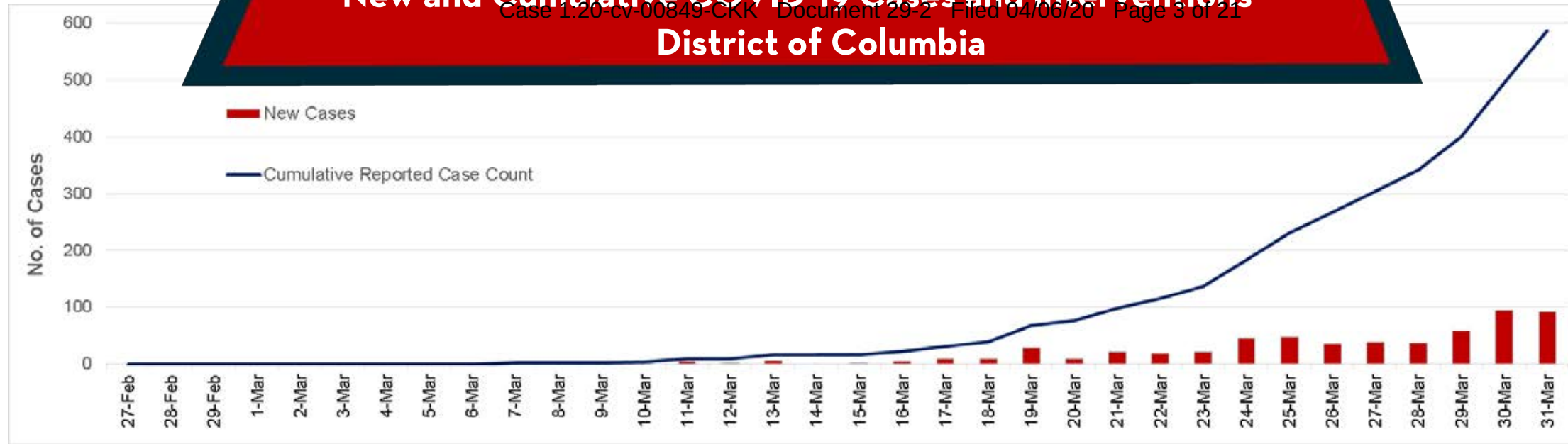

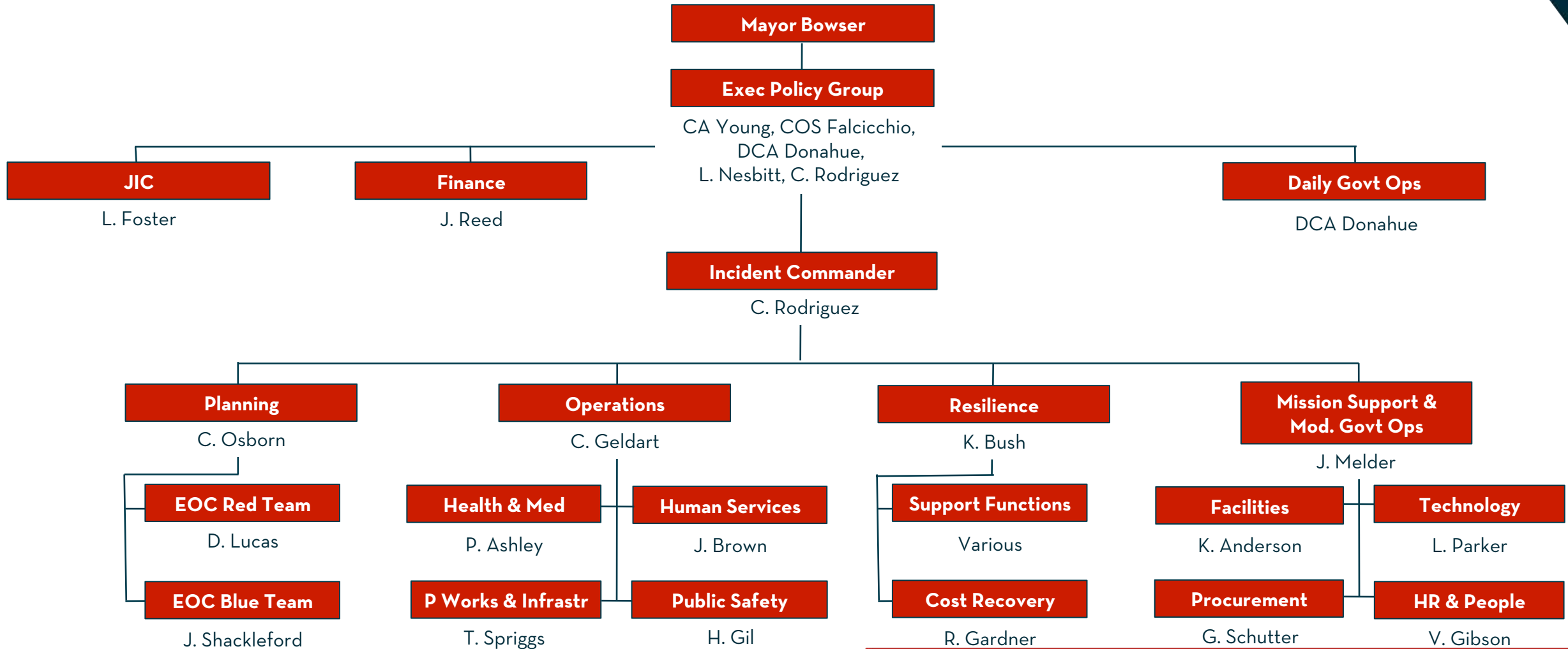

District Response Org Chart

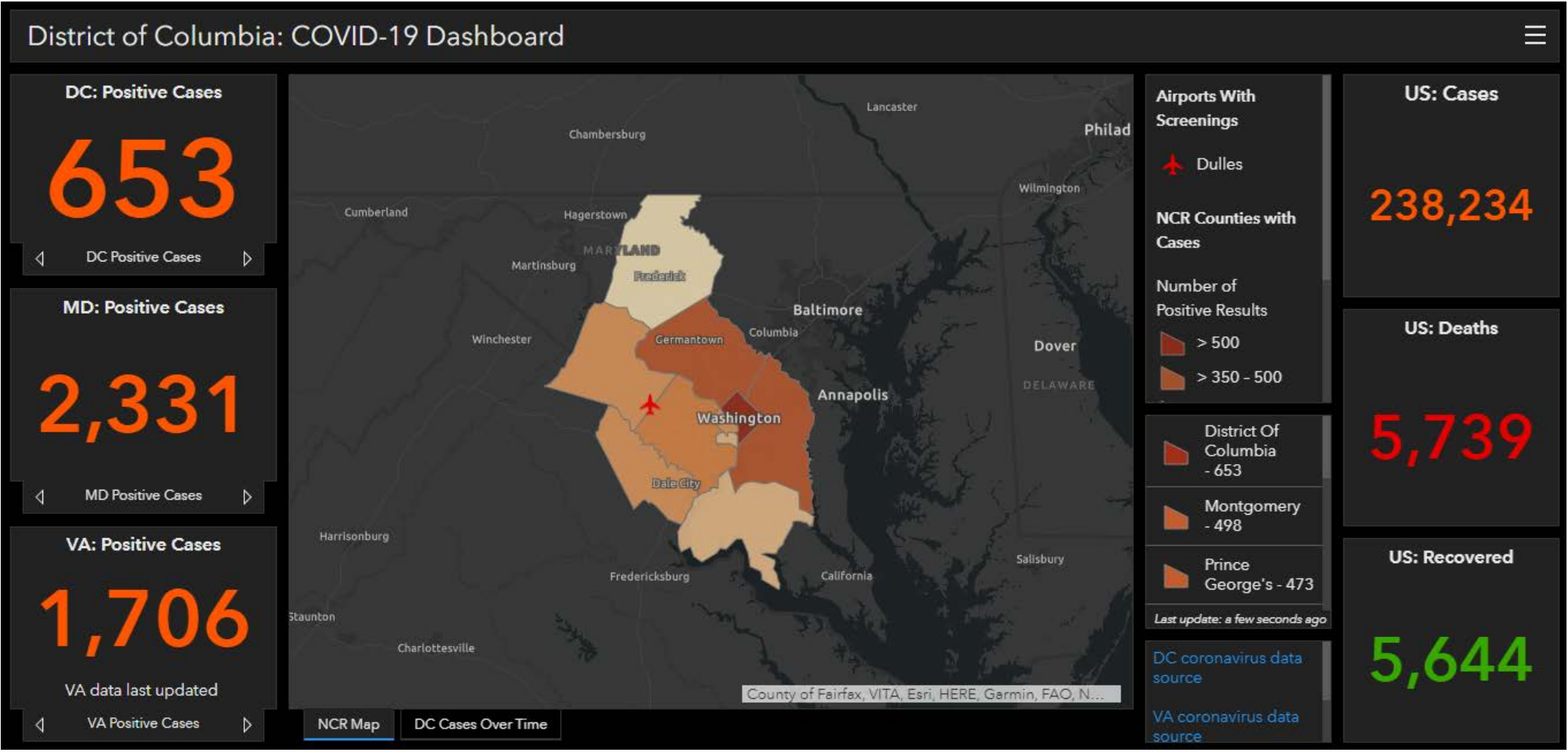

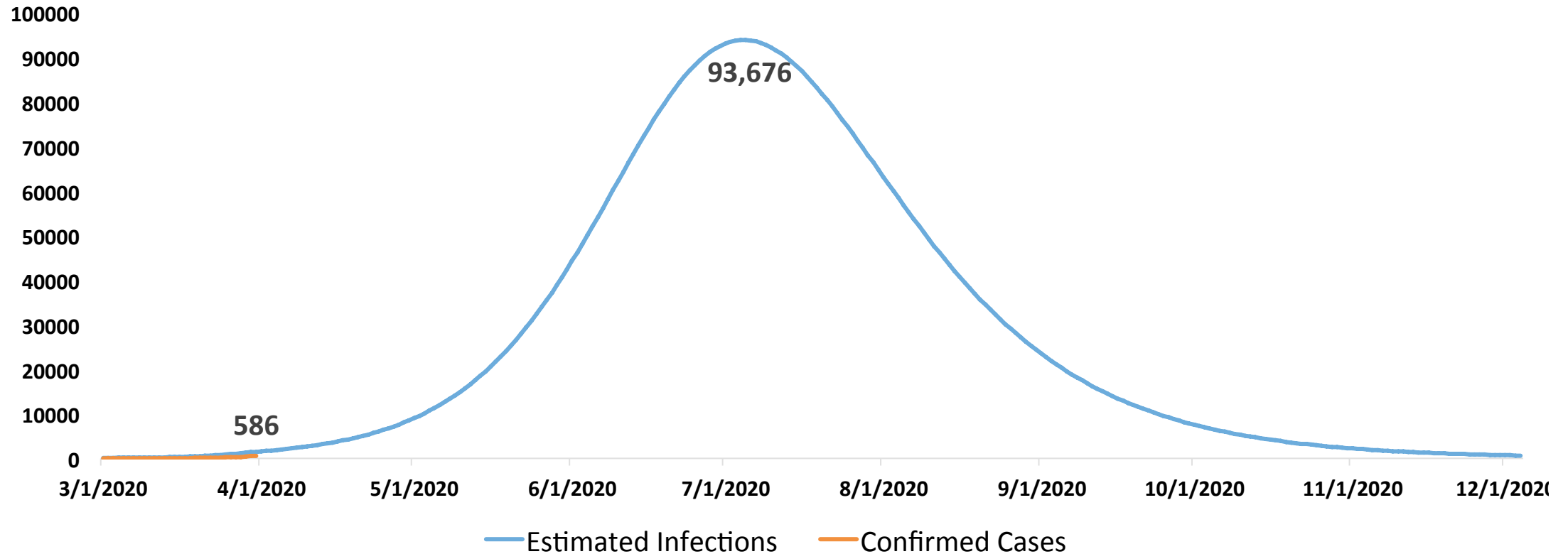

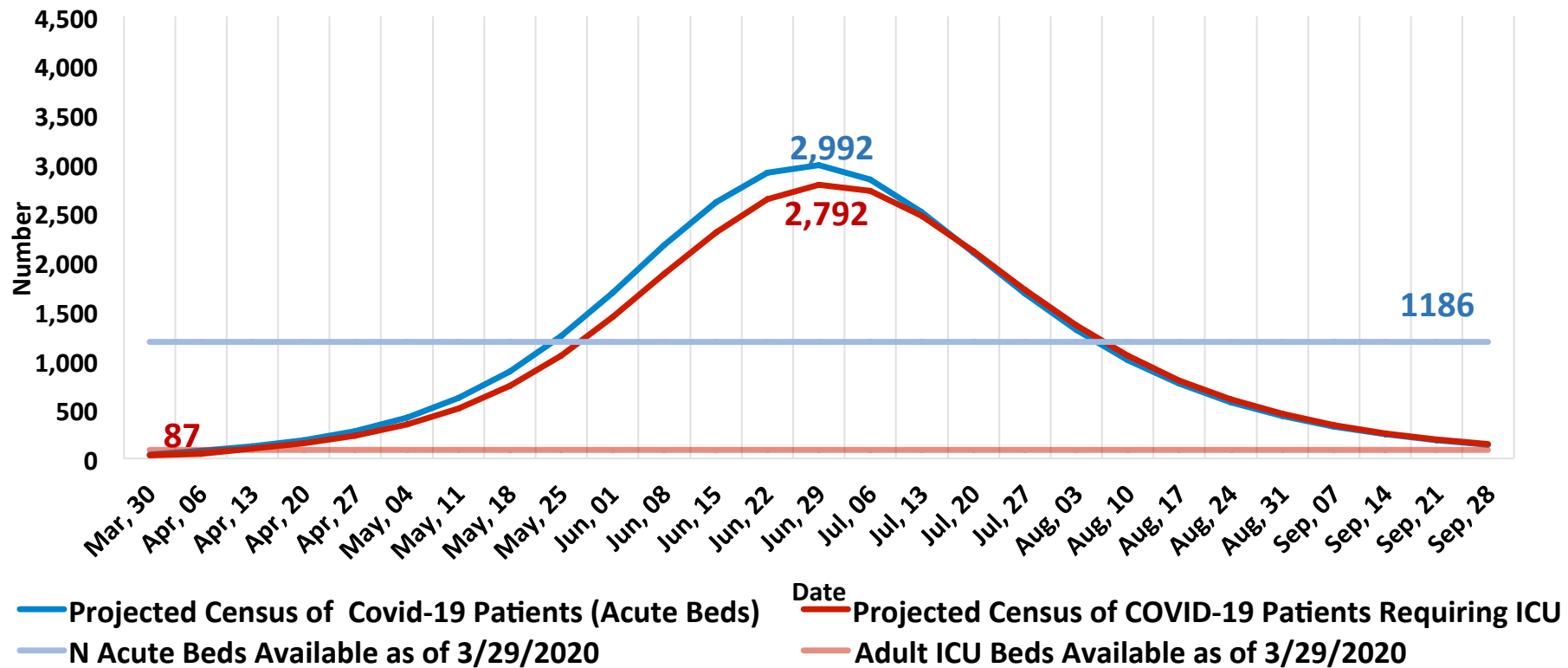

(Schedule Modification-COVID-19)

In these unprecedented times, DOC appreciates you and your ongoing dedication, professionalism and support of the mission. Due to COVID-19, and in anticipation of the upcoming critical weeks, we are at critical juncture for staffing. Therefore, **effective Sunday, April 5, 2020**, DOC will transition to 12 hours for the majority of Correctional Officers. Initiating a 12-hour shift will allow for more coverage to secure the facility without drafting staff to work an additional eight (8) hours of overtime following their normal shift.

In making this transition, DOC will make the best effort to ensure that most Officers will continue on their same post assignments. Additionally, DOC will try to make the best effort to ensure your placement on a shift that best accommodates your needs. You will receive your modified schedule **no later than Friday, April 3rd**. Any questions or concerns regarding your schedule should be forwarded to the Deputy Warden of your assigned facility (CDF- Deputy Warden K. Landerkin and CTF- Deputy Warden M. Jones). Please see the attached Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for more information regarding the schedule modification.

Under the current circumstances, DOC is aware that caregiver duties especially child care are of utmost concern. To that end the District is offering free childcare for first responders. The details are as follows: Bright Horizons (various locations) or Shaw Community Center located at 1701 11th Street NW. These are programs for children ages 5-14.

1. All the adults are cleared through DCHR for MPD and FBI and cleared through CFSA for the CPR.
2. There is 1 adult to every 4 children and no more than 8 children in any one room at one time (we have worked extensively on cleaning and social distancing protocols to minimize risk.).

The D.C. Department of Corrections' vision is to be a benchmark correction agency. To become benchmark agency, we will serve with pride, passion and professionalism in caring for human lives.

3. The program is free to government employees.
4. The hours are from 7:30am – 6:00 pm and children can be dropped off/picked-up between those hours.
5. Breakfast and lunch will be provided for the child.
6. The program will support academic and enrichment throughout the day.
7. The provider is using their own facilities but has a contract with a cleaning company for enhanced cleaning.
8. Additional protocols will be shared by the provider upon confirmation of enrollment as slots are limited.

Dear Mr. Olubasusi:

I want to begin by emphasizing Management's strong appreciation to staff for their professionalism and dedication in ensuring the safety and well-being of their fellow colleagues and the residents. We are always available to talk to staff and listen to their concerns as we work together to respond to this unprecedented pandemic. I appreciate the sense of duty all our staff exhibits each day they serve our residents and protect our city.

On March 5, 2020, the DC Department of Corrections activated the Incident Command Team (ICT) in anticipation of coronavirus (COVID-19). The ICT is composed of Operations/Planning, Human Resources, Logistics and Supplies, Communication, and Medical staff. At the same time that we activated the ICT, we decided to initiate an enhanced cleaning effort of all areas and facilities on a two-hour basis. Further, plans were made and immediately implemented to conduct medical screenings (a questionnaire and temperature checks) of all individuals entering DOC's facilities. As the COVID-19 situation further evolved and it became clear there was substantial community spread of the virus, we took immediate action to limit public access to DOC facilities, halting all visitors and volunteers with the exception of legal visits.

As soon as the District activated its Emergency Operation Center (EOC) on March 6, DOC began working closely with the EOC to obtain additional custodial supplies and personal protective equipment (PPE) to ensure we had a replenishable inventory. As you know, as the situation continued to evolve, DOC kept staff apprised of the actions we were taking through the use of daily open letters and having medical staff attend roll calls to address any staff concerns. We are committed to keeping our staff fully informed with timely and accurate information. Since the activation of the ICT, communication to staff regarding the prevention and mitigation of COVID-19 has been disseminated daily, as well as posted throughout all areas of the DOC facilities. Based on Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines, DOC worked with Human

Resources to identify staff members considered high risk and took appropriate action to reduce the potential of their coming in contact with COVID-19.

For the past several weeks, DOC has increased its custodial and PPE supplies. However, as we have seen happening in cities across the country, procuring additional PPE supplies is a very significant challenge. DOC is following the guidelines from the CDC and DC Health, and is providing PPE to staff working isolation and quarantine units, as well as staff who provide escort and/or transport of confirmed or suspected COVID-19 cases. DOC also provides PPE to the laundry, screening, and cleaning staff.

Additionally, DOC has procured medical-grade cleaning supplies which are disseminated to staff upon supervisors' request. We know that disinfectant wipes have been in great demand, both within our facilities as well as throughout the city. As we receive new supplies of disinfectant wipes, we distribute them to staff. We have also allowed staff to bring in their own personal supply of disinfectant wipes. The nationwide demand for hand sanitizer has presented a challenge in our efforts to supply sufficient quantities. We believe the District Government's creative solution in using local distilleries and other small businesses to manufacture hand sanitizer will help meet the high demand for its resupply. We will continue to allow staff to bring in their own 3 oz. bottles of hand sanitizer.

As you have undoubtedly seen every two hours, DOC has janitorial staff clean and wipe down common areas such as the roll call room, ODRs, locker rooms, and elevators, as well as facilities entrances and the Inmate Reception Center. Every two hours, public address system announcements remind staff to wash their hands and wipe down their work areas. We remain committed to ensuring our workplace is as safe and clean as possible to ensure the health of our staff and our residents.

Attached are responses to the questions you raised. Please let me know if you have any additional questions or concerns. My staff and I are always available to assist.

Please describe DOC's efforts in partnering and/or sharing information with criminal justice partners?

DOC's Director and General Counsel regularly meet with our criminal justice partners to share information regarding the impact of COVID-19 on our operations and our responses.

Are daily updates continuing to be sent via emails to the staff regarding COVID-19? Can you please make those available?

Yes, COVID-19 updates are regularly sent to the agency's staff and posted on the agency's website.

Have DOC employees (officers and medical staff) been provided appropriate protective devices/material/training? Are staff members knowledgeable on and adequately equipped to prevent transmission, minimize spread and protect themselves and the inmate population from contacting COVID-19?

PPE is available to staff, training is ongoing and continuous, and signage has been posted throughout the facilities instructing staff and residents on how to prevent transmission and minimize the spread of the virus.

Is DOC working in close connection with the DC Health? What medical support does the Agency have specifically for the virus?

DOC and its medical contractor, Unity Healthcare, are in constant communication with DC Health.

Are all incoming inmates, staff and other individuals with access to the DOC facilities questioned as to their level of risk?

Yes, every person entering DOC's facilities are screened for possible COVID-19 exposure and flu-like symptoms.

What is the procedure for processing all new inmates to the facilities?

All new intakes will be housed on S2 for a 14-day quarantine while undergoing enhanced monitoring by medical staff.

What is the procedure for assessing the risk to existing inmates?

DOC uses CDC and DC Health guidelines to screen residents with questions about possible exposure to COVID-19, flu-like symptoms they may be experiencing, and temperature checks. This is done across all facilities receiving arrestees and resident, and is done every time there is an entry into the facilities. For example, if a resident leaves for court or medical appointments, they will receive the screening upon their return regardless of how long their length of stay has been.

What testing is being offered to confirm a diagnosis of COVID-19?

DOC and Unity Healthcare share patient medical information with DC Health, which makes the decision on COVID-19 testing.

What procedures are in place if an inmate is symptomatic?

DOC staff and medical staff are provided masks and gloves when they are in close proximity to an isolated or quarantined resident.

What procedures are in place if an inmate tests positive?

Upon receiving notification that a resident has tested positive for COVID-19, the resident is given a mask. The resident is then placed in isolation for the duration of time recommended by CDC, while receiving medical attention. DOC staff and medical staff are provided masks and gloves when working in the area housing residents in isolation.

What procedures are in place for quarantines?

DOC residents suspected of having COVID-19 are placed in quarantine units where they are monitored by DOC's medical staff. DOC staff and medical staff working in the quarantine units are provided masks and gloves, and the residents are provided with masks. As of today, there are 125 residents in quarantine units.

Asymptomatic inmates currently housed at any of the facilities who are at high-risk for contracting COVID-19?

DOC is following CDC and DC Health guidelines, which does not include testing of asymptomatic individuals.

Symptomatic inmates currently housed at any of the facilities? If so, what actions are being taken with regard to those individuals?

DOC's medical staff conducts rounds for identification of symptomatic residents. If the medical staff notices a symptomatic resident during their rounds, the resident is brought to medical for examination.

Inmates currently housed at any of the facilities who have tested positive for COVID-19?

As of today, 12 residents have tested positive and all are in isolation per CDC and DC Health guidelines. Notably, these residents are presently stable. However, if their conditions warrant, they will be promptly transported to a local hospital so they may receive any needed care that cannot be provided onsite.

What is being done to track any inmates, visitors, staff, or other individuals with access to any of the facilities who have been at any DOC facility within the past two weeks, including any individuals who were held and released or transferred?

DOC is utilizing the screening forms for tracking purposes. And, as you know, tracking of arrestees and resident is a regular and routine DOC business practice.

What is the impact of the Agency's response to the Mayor's Order 2020-048: Prohibition on Mass Gatherings During Public Health Emergency - Coronavirus (COVID-19)?

In compliance with Mayor's Order 2020-04 and as part of its efforts to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in its facilities, DOC has suspended all non-legal counsel visits and halted most resident off-unit movement and activities.
