Accordingly, the County shall have until noon on May 20, 2020 to file a written response to the motion. Upon review of that filing, the court will determine whether a reply will be authorized and/or whether a hearing will be necessary. In lieu of an opposition, and in light of the fact that at least some of the concerns raised by at least one of the Plaintiffs have been addressed by waiving in person presentment, the parties are strongly encouraged to meet and confer in an effort to reach accord on the emergent issues raised in the motion. In light of the fact that no defendant has made an appearance in this case, Plaintiffs are instructed to serve a copy of this minute order on the County by hand delivery today or overnight delivery (to arrive Monday morning). Plaintiffs' counsel also shall email a copy to the Deputy County Counsel who has held himself out as representing the County on this matter and shall place a courtesy phone call to that individual informing him of this minute order signed by District Judge Dale A.
