Dkt. 10 . Like this case, all of those other cases challenge the constitutionality of a provision in the CARES Act, 26 U.S.C. § 6428(g)(1)(B), that limits payments to U.S. citizens whose spouses do not have a social security number. Because the parties acknowledge that one or more of those cases could be dispositive, this case is DISMISSED without prejudice.
