JOINT STATUS REPORT

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22 The American Civil Liberties Union of Arizona (“Plaintiff” or “ACLU-AZ”)
23 and the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and U.S. Customs and Border
24 Protection (“Defendants” and together with the Plaintiff, the “Parties”), through
25 their respective counsel, submit this status report pursuant to this Court’s Order of
26 April 9, 2019 [Dkt. No. 69].

1 1. This case involves a Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”) request
2 submitted by Plaintiff to Defendants, seeking U.S. Customs and Border Protection
3 (“CBP”) records. As of December 4, 2018, CBP reported that the processing of
4 records potentially responsive to Plaintiff’s FOIA request was completed on
5 October 31, 2018 [Dkt. No. 59].

6 2. The parties previously reported that they have determined that no
7 dispositive motions will be required [Dkt. No. 64]. The parties continue to discuss
8 how to resolve any remaining issues in the case, including Plaintiff’s alleged
9 entitlement to attorneys’ fees.

10 3. If a mutual resolution cannot be reached regarding Plaintiff’s
11 attorneys’ fees on or before May 24, 2019, Plaintiff will file a motion for an award
12 of its reasonable attorneys’ fees pursuant to the FOIA as directed by the Court’s
13 Order of April 9, 2019. Resolution of Plaintiff’s motion for award of attorneys’
14 fees, if needed, will resolve all remaining issues in this litigation.
