ORDER

On August 19, 2013, the Government filed a consent motion for an extension of time to respond to Microsoft Corporation’s motion. The Government represents therein that Microsoft Corporation, through counsel, “consents to the relief sought in this motion.”

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that the briefing schedule in this matter is revised as follows: any response by the Government to Microsoft Corporation’s Motion for Declaratory Judgment or Other Appropriate Relief Authorizing Disclosure of Aggregate Data Regarding FISA Orders must be submitted no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 30, 2013. If the Government responds, Microsoft Corporation may file a reply brief no later than 5:00 p.m. on September 9, 2013, through the Security and Emergency Planning Staff, U.S. Department of Justice.
