The Court has considered the application for a temporary restraining order seeking immediate release, filed in connection with a petition for a writ of *habeas corpus*, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241, challenging the conditions of confinement, by Petitioner Yoselin Gabriela Reina Moran, together with the moving and opposing papers.

Petitioner is, currently, detained at the Adelanto Detention Center ["Adelanto"], in San Bernardino County, which is within the Central District of California. Petitioner asserts that, in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, the conditions of her confinement are, now, unconstitutional. Petitioner is a civil detainee.

The Court incorporates by reference into this order the factual and legal grounds 1 supporting emergency injunctive relief, namely, immediate release, set forth in the 2 Court's orders issued in *Castillo v. Barr*, CV 20-00605-TJH (AFMx)(C.D. Cal. Mar. 3 27, 2020), ECF No. 32; and Hernandez v. Wolf, CV 20-60017-TJH (KSx)(C.D. Cal. 4 Apr. 1, 2020), ECF No. 17. 5 In the absence of class certification, a temporary restraining order may be issued 6 only for a named plaintiff. See Nat'l Ctr. for Immigrants Rights, Inc. v. INS, 743 F.2d 7 1365, 1371 (9th Cir.1984). 8 Based on the incorporated factual and legal grounds, and the facts and arguments 9 presented, here, regarding the Fifth Amendment, 10 It is Ordered that the application for a temporary restraining order be, and 11 hereby is, Granted. 12 It is further Ordered that Respondents shall, by 5:00 p.m. on April 10, 2020, 13 release Petitioner Yoselin Gabriela Reina Moran from custody pending further order 14 of this Court. 15 It is further Ordered that Petitioner shall not violate any federal, state or 16 local laws. 17 It is further Ordered that Respondents shall show cause, if they have any, 18 as to why the Court should not issue a preliminary injunction in this case. 19 Respondents' response, if any, to this order to show cause shall be filed by Noon on 20 April 17, 2020. Petitioner's reply, if any, to Respondents' response shall be filed by 21 Noon on April 22, 2020. The matter will then stand submitted. 22 23 Date: April 10, 2020 24 Teny J.
