Marshals Service ("USMS") pretrial or post-conviction detainees who are considered medically vulnerable and who are housed at Otay Mesa Detention Center. (ECF No. 61 at 11). On May 22, 2020, Defendants filed their response in opposition to Plaintiffs' motion. (ECF No. 68). Having considered Defendants' response, the Court requests Defendants address and present evidence on the conditions of confinement at Otay Mesa Detention Center. Accordingly, Defendants shall file their supplemental response on or before May 29, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. Plaintiffs may file a sur-reply on or before June 3, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. Oral argument will proceed as presently scheduled.
