
ORDER REQUIRING RESPONSE

On May 15, 2020, Plaintiffs filed a motion for preliminary injunction, seeking the release from custody, enlargement, and/or transfer to home confinement for all U.S.

1 Marshals Service (“USMS”) pretrial or post-conviction detainees who are considered
2 medically vulnerable and who are housed at Otay Mesa Detention Center. (ECF No. 61 at
3 11). On May 22, 2020, Defendants filed their response in opposition to Plaintiffs’ motion.
4 (ECF No. 68). Having considered Defendants’ response, the Court requests Defendants
5 address and present evidence on the conditions of confinement at Otay Mesa Detention
6 Center. Accordingly, Defendants shall file their supplemental response on or before **May**
7 **29, 2020 at 9:00 a.m.** Plaintiffs may file a sur-reply on or before **June 3, 2020 at 12:00**
8 **p.m.** Oral argument will proceed as presently scheduled.
