The Court today entered the following order in the above-entitled case:

The motion of Scholar Seth Barrett Tillman, et al. for leave to file a brief as *amici curiae* is granted. The petition for a writ of certiorari is granted. The judgment is vacated, and the case is remanded to the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit with instructions to dismiss the case as moot. See *United States v.
