ORDER

The court's order of June 7, 1977 is modified in the following particular:

The defendants will not be required to have a male guard on duty on the fifth floor of the present jail so long as the defendants do not place on said fifth floor any males except those classified as "low-risk misdemeanor defendants." The required number of matrons will still be utilized on the fifth floor as contemplated in this court's original order.

This order is being entered <u>ex parte</u> due to the fact that the juveniles, heretofore housed on the fifth floor, are being removed from this fifth floor to the new Juvenile Detention Center and the above change is needed to alleviate crowded conditions. Further, the court has been advised that an entire new jail structure will be completed on or about March 1, 1981 and this change will be in effect only until the new jail is completed.

In the event the counsel for the plaintiffs and intervenor wish to object to the entry of this order, such objection shall be filed and considered by the court, but the objection should be filed on or before December 1, 1980. In the meantime, the changes may be initiated by the defendants as above contemplated.
