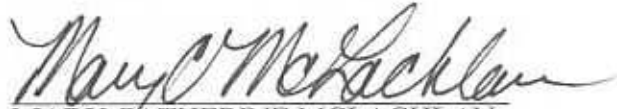

2 Terminating Relief Provisions of the Release and Settlement Agreement signed by the parties.

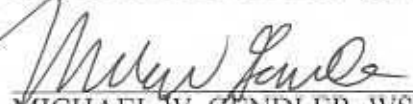
