ORDER OF ADMINISTRATIVE STAY

Defendants filed a motion to stay this action pending the conclusion of proceedings in Texas v. Biden, -- F. Supp. 3d ----, 2021 WL 3603341 (N.D. Tex. Aug 13, 2021). [ECF No. 18]. Defendants also move for an administrative stay of all deadlines in this case, including Plaintiff's deadline to file a preliminary injunction and Defendants' deadline to answer the amended complaint. [ECF No. 20]. Plaintiff responded in opposition to both motions to stay. [ECF No. 22].

The Defendants in <u>Texas v. Biden</u> have filed a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari with the Supreme Court of the United States.

The Court, having sound discretion to stay these proceedings, hereby **ORDERS** an **ADMINISTRATIVE STAY** of this action pending resolution of the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari filed in Texas

v. Biden. This stay includes the deadlines for any motion for preliminary injunction and Defendants' answer or responsive pleading to the amended complaint. Therefore, the motion for administrative stay [ECF No. 20] is **GRANTED** and Defendants' motion to stay [ECF No. 18] pending the *conclusion* of proceedings in <u>Texas</u> v. Biden is **DENIED** without prejudice with leave to refile.

It is so **ORDERED**.
