13	* * * * THE COURT: The court has been informed of the	
14	tensions existing in the CPSU as a result of events,	
15	particularly of the past week, resulting in injuries both to

19	representatives of the Legal Aid Society representing the

23	religious services may be held in the	day rooms of the unit.
24	2. The law library may be	closed on Saturday,

2		3. An observer in each block shall be on hand	
3		from the Investigative Division of the department.	
. 4		As a matter of law, representatives from the New	
5		York Board of Correction have the authority to observe the

7		The IAD observers shall be on duty for the day	
. 8		and the evening tours on Saturday and Sunday April 16th and	
9		17th.	
10		All searches of inmates shall be videotaped by	
11		Department of Correction personnel. The above mentioned IAI	
12		observers shall be provided with hand-held video cameras in	
13		order to videotape such out-of-cell movement or inmate and	
14		staff activity as they deem appropriate.
