Upon the annexed affidavit of Benjamin Ward dated November 4, 1982 it is ordered that:

1. Plaintiffs show cause before the Hon. Morris E. Lasker at the United States Courthouse, Foley Square, New York, New York, on November 12, 1982 at 11:30 o'clock a.m., or as soon as counsel can be heard in Room 1103 why an order should not be entered suspending during the period of emergency caused by a strike of attorneys employed by the Legal Aid Society those portions of the Court's orders of September 3, 1980 and June 23, 1981 which limits the total population of the House of Detention for Men at a level not exceeding 1200 inmates and which requires that detainees housed in dormitories located in Anna M. Kross (C-95) be afforded housing space in excess of 60 square feet and which further limits the population of the dormitories in C-95 to no more than 50 inmates.

2. Pending the hearing and determination of this application, the orders of the Court dated September 3, 1980 and June 23, 1981 limiting the population of the House of Detention for Men to 1200 inmates and requiring that the number of inmates housed in dormitories in the Anna M. Kross facility (C-95) be limited to 50 and that each inmate be afforded between 66 and 76 square feet of housing space is suspended.

3. Personal service of a copy of the Order and the papers upon which it was granted upon the Legal Aid Society Prisoner's Rights Project 15 Park Row, New York, New York, on or before November 10, 1982, by 4:30 p.m., shall be good and sufficient service.

4. Plaintiffs shall serve answering affidavits and a memorandum of law, if any, on defendants' counsel on or by November 1982 by m.
