On November 8, 1993, the court entered its Order re: Environmental Health Work Plan for Sanitation ("Order"). The background and basis for the Order is stated therein.

The Environmental Health Work Plan for Sanitation requires the submission and implementation of an improved system of delivering sanitation supplies. Based on experience and discussions since the entry of the Order, the parties and the Office of Compliance Consultants have agreed that the Work Plan provisions concerning supply delivery should be supplemented.

It is therefore ORDERED that:

1. The Environmental Health Work Plan for Sanitation, adopted by the court in its Order re: Environmental Health Work Plan for Sanitation dated November 8, 1993, is hereby amended by the addition to Task IV, at page 8, of the following provisions:

<u>ACTIVITY</u>	<u>ACTIVITY DATE</u>
37) City to review effectiveness of supply plan as implemented in ensuring the consistent provision of adequate sanitation and housekeeping supplies in all facilities and in all areas within facilities	6/30/95
38) City to submit results of supply plan review to OCC and LAS	7/31/95
39) Parties to discuss results of supply plan review and agree on any necessary modifications of supply plan (by written comments and/or meeting, as agreed between the parties)	8/15/95

2. Unexcused noncompliance with the foregoing added work plan provisions shall subject the defendants to monetary penalties pursuant to the court's separate Order re: Compliance with Work Plan Deadlines, entered July 10, 1992.

3. The Order re: Environmental Health Work Plan dated November 8, 1993, shall continue in full force and effect except as explicitly modified in this Order.
