Major Accomplishments and Issues Addressed

- 1. Receiver Agreement executed by HUD, CHA, and Receiver.
- Annual Contributions Contract (ACC) between HUD and CHA executed and initial funding of \$1,400,000 received by the Receiver.
- 3. Insurance coverage for the Receiver and the Scattered Site Properties placed in force.
- 4. Management of most of the existing scattered site properties transferred from CHA to the Receiver.
- 5. Director hired for Scattered Site Program effective January 4, 1988.
