The following is our report regarding the status and implementation of the Scattered Site Housing Program since the last report.

### Major Accomplishments and Issues Addressed

- 1. Director for Scattered Site Program has started work full-time.
- Recruitment of additional staff has begun.
- Two architectural firms have been retained to begin evaluation of properties.
- 4. The process of securing (board up) and winterizing properties is underway.
- 5. All heating systems and other utilities are functioning in occupied buildings. Two tenants were relocated from buildings without heat to those with heat.
- 6. The transfer of all properties from CHA to Receiver is complete.

  Video tapes of all properties are in the process of being made.

### Summary of Major Meetings and Activities

The following is a chronological list of the major meetings and activities during December regarding the Scattered Site Housing Program. This does not include many informal meetings and extended telephone conversations among Habitat personnel, our attorneys, HUD attorneys, and various personnel from CHA, the HUD area, regional and central office and personnel with the Department of Housing - City of Chicago.

December 7, 1987 <u>Letter to HUD - Chicago</u>

Use of contractors, architects and other professionals in evaluating properties.

HUD responded with a letter indicating that contractors or professionals used in the property evaluation process would not be prohibited from future work.

December 9, 1987 <u>In-House Management Meeting</u>

December 15, 1987

Sign-Off Inspection for Each Property

On site inspection and video taping begun of each occupied property. Residents served with notice of management transfer from CHA to The Habitat Company. CHA and Habitat personnel present.

December 23, 1987

New Director of Scattered Site Program begins.

Amount Received \$1,416,778.00

Expenses Paid \$ 556,491.37

Remaining Budget \$1,788,508.63

The current fund balance is invested. The expenses paid include payment of \$513,119 for insurance.

A separate escrow account has been established for tenant rents.

No rental income was received in 1987.

### Summary

Preliminary development schedules and preliminary production schedules have been prepared and are in the process of being implemented. With the hiring of staff personnel during the next month or so we expect to accelerate our planning activities and continue our close working relationship with HUD, both locally and in Washington.

Our staff inspections found many buildings open to the weather and vandals for an extended time. In some cases, we discovered the actual property to differ from the property description attached to the Court Order. For example, three sites listed as "Vacant - Available for New Construction" actually have buildings on them. The updated list is attached.

We would be pleased to meet with you to discuss any aspect of this report.

During 1988, our activities will be reported to you on a quarterly basis, in accordance with the Court Order, of August 14, 1987.
