AGREED ORDER

This matter coming to be heard on the Joint Motion of Plaintiffs and Defendant Chicago Housing Authority for an order waiving the restriction on families with children in public housing units above the third floor for one building located at the northwest corner of Clybourn and Division Streets in the Near North Revitalizing Area that does not meet the criteria listed in the modified Judgment Order for automatic waiver of said restriction.

The Court having heard from parties concerning the proposed order; and

The Court being cognizant that the principal remedial purpose of the orders previously entered in this case has been to provide plaintiff class families with desegregated housing opportunities; and


The Court being authorized to issue orders in this case “designed. . .to achieve results consistent with [the Judgement Order]” (304 F. Supp. 736, 741); and

The Court being of the view, based on the representations of the parties, that the proposal to locate public housing units above the third floor in this building is designed to achieve results consistent with the Judgement Order previously entered in this case;

Now, therefore, IT IS HEARBY ORDERED:

The Chicago Housing Authority shall be free, subject to approval of the location of the units by plaintiffs' counsel, to house families with children in units above the third floor in the building to be located at the northwest corner of Clybourn and Division Streets, provided, however, that the units are and remain well-distributed among the non-public housing units to be constructed in the building. The general restriction on housing families in public housing above the third story unless all conditions in the Order dated August 6, 2015 are met remains in effect unless otherwise ordered by this court.
