Dear Key Crewmember:

Greetings from the American Seafoods Company office! The 1999 Pollock "A" Season is coming up soon and we wanted to update you on recent changes in the industry, schedules for the vessels, mandatory training and meetings, and a few other issues.

We indicated in our last crew meeting that the offshore industry was discussing the development of a Pollock Conservation Cooperative. There are several benefits of a cooperative arrangement but the primary benefits include a slower, more deliberate harvesting schedule, improved resource utilization, higher quality and safer operating conditions. For all these reasons, American Seafoods Company was in favor of such an agreement if the right terms could be reached. This week, all of the at-sea processing companies were successful in reaching an agreement to form a Pollock Conservation Cooperative.


With this new operating scenario scheduled to take place in A season 1999, we had to quickly formulate a strategy to maximize our operational and fishing efficiencies. The most significant decision we have made is to operate fewer vessels and after careful analysis, we have chosen not to operate the American Dynasty for the 1999 A season. The six remaining vessels will operate under a revised schedule as dictated by recent changes by North Pacific fisheries management. The A season will be split into two fishing periods with a mandatory 5 day stand down period between them. A1 will begin January 20, 1999 and A2 will begin February 20, 1999. There will also be a B season and C season, B opening August 1, 1999 and C opening September 15, 1999. The Aleutian Island area will be closed to directed fishing.

With so many changes in the industry and many uncertainties still ahead, American Seafoods Company must change some of our business practices. One major change for Key Crewmembers will be seasonal daily rate contracts offered for the 1999 Pollock A season. There will be no annual guarantee of days for 1999. The daily rates and hourly shipyard rates for Pollock A season will remain the same as the rates that were paid for 1998. Those crewmembers currently covered under our insurance program will continue to be insured.

Contracts for Key Crewmembers will be signed according to the enclosed schedule. Please remember to bring your identification and a voided check if you will be electing electronic deposit of funds for your payroll. Enclosed you will also find a schedule for the vessels crew up and departures, as well as schedules for numerous training sessions and meetings for many of the key positions. We are instituting a Hearing Conservation Program and will be performing baseline hearing tests on all deck, engine, and factory key crew in conjunction with contract signing. The meetings and training sessions prior to the season are vital to the continued success of American Seafoods Company and your professional development. Some courses require mandatory attendance to meet our legal requirements, others are intended to help you succeed in a very challenging working environment. In either case, you are accountable to know and apply the material covered in the meetings for which you are scheduled. It is important that you clock in and out for these meetings, as well as signing in on the sign up sheets that will be available at all meetings to ensure that you are paid in a timely manner.

If you have questions, please contact your Vessel Operations Manager or Reneé Vargas. We wish you a very special holiday season and peace and prosperity in the New Year.
