ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT AND DENYING DEFENDANTS' MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment and Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment are now before the Court for consideration. After thoroughly reviewing the Motions, supporting materials, and language of House Bill 1595, and giving the parties an opportunity to be heard on February 19, 2010, the Court finds that House Bill 1595 violates the single subject rule set forth in Article V, Section 57 of the Oklahoma Constitution. As a result, the statute is void, of no effect, and unenforceable.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that:

- 1. Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment is GRANTED;
- 2. Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment is DENIED;

3. House Bill 1595 is found to violate the single subject rule set forth in Article V, Section 57 of the Oklahoma Constitution because it contains multiple subjects that are not germane, relative, and cognate to a readily apparent common theme and purpose. Therefore, House Bill 1595 is found to be void, of no effect, and unenforceable by Defendants' employees, agents, and successors in office.
