<u>ORDER</u>

Appellant's Emergency Motion for a Temporary Injunction Pending Appeal to Preserve the Status Quo is granted. *Oklahoma Pub. Employees Ass'n v. Oklahoma Military Dep't*, 2014 OK 48, ¶ 15, 330 P.3d 497, 504; *Dowell v. Pletcher*, 2013 OK 50, ¶¶ 6-7, 304 P.3d 457, 460. The Court hereby grants a temporary injunction against enforcement of Oklahoma House Bill 1721 (HB 1721, 2015 Okla. Sess. Laws, Ch. 59) during the pending appeal. *Whole Woman's Health v. Hellerstedt*, 136 S.Ct. 2292, 195 L.Ed.2d 665 (2016); *Oklahoma Coal. for Reprod. Justice v. Cline*,

2019 OK 33, ¶¶ 16-20, 441 P.3d 1145, 1151-52. Appellees, their employees, agents, and successors in office are hereby temporarily enjoined from enforcing the provisions of this Act until and unless the Court orders otherwise.
