The files for the remaining cases shall be administratively closed.

2. The Attorney General's Motion to Intervene is **GRANTED**. The Attorney General shall be permitted to conduct discovery, to respond to the Plaintiffs' Motions for Temporary Injunction, and otherwise to file responsive pleadings or responsive motions. The parties may request a hearing to resolve any outstanding issues concerning the participation of the Attorney General as Intervenor-Defendant.
3. The parties are directed to confer regarding a schedule for Plaintiffs' Motions for Temporary Injunction and to confer regarding any discovery that Defendants believe necessary in order to fully brief the motions. The Parties shall submit an agreed schedule to the Court if one is reached. If agreement cannot be reached, parties shall appear on January 25, 2023 at 10:00 AM (EST) so that the Court may issue a briefing schedule.
