## ORDER

\*1 The judgment of the District Court is vacated, and the case is remanded for further proceedings consistent with *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization*, No. 19–1392 (U.S. June 24, 2022). This court does not now address the district court's rulings based on the First Amendment, because they were influenced by pre-*Dobbs* decisions holding that abortion is a fundamental right. The District Court should reconsider all claims in this litigation in light of *Dobbs* and the government-speech doctrine of *Pleasant Grove v. Summum*, 555 U.S. 460 (2009), and *Walker v. Texas Division, Sons of* 

Confederate Veterans, Inc., 576 U.S. 200 (2015). Any appeals from the decision on remand will return to this panel.
