The Court enters findings of facts and conclusions of law on the record and finds liability in favor of plaintiff Everson and EEOC on plaintiffs' claims under federal and state law.

The Court finds for defendant Laidlaw Transit, Inc., dba Laidlaw Education Services, a wholly owned subsidiary of Laidlaw Transportation Corp. on the issues of punitive damages and injunctive relief.

Plaintiff Everson is awarded judgment for \$3,029.78 economic damages, and \$30,000 in non-economic damages with costs and attorneys' fees.
