10 **Jury Verdict.** This action came before the Court for a
11 trial by jury. The issues have been tried and the jury
12 has rendered its verdict.

13 **Decision by Court.** This action came to trial or
14 hearing before the Court. The issues have been tried
15 or heard and a decision has been rendered.

16 IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT

17 The Court enters findings of facts and conclusions of
18 law on the record and finds liability in favor of
19 plaintiff Everson and EEOC on plaintiffs' claims under
20 federal and state law.

21 The Court finds for defendant Laidlaw Transit, Inc.,
22 dba Laidlaw Education Services, a wholly owned
23 subsidiary of Laidlaw Transportation Corp. on the
24 issues of punitive damages and injunctive relief.

25 Plaintiff Everson is awarded judgment for \$3,029.78
26 economic damages, and \$30,000 in non-economic damages
27 with costs and attorneys' fees.

28 Plaintiff Everson is awarded \$9,115 to offset the
additional federal income tax consequences arising from
the damages award.
