ORDER OF COMMISSIONERS COURT
OF STARR COUNTY, TEXAS
SETTING POLICY FOR
PROHIBITION OF ELECTIONEERING IN OR ON
PROPERTY OWNED OR UNDER THE CARE, CUSTODY
AND CONTROL OF THE COUNTY OF STARR

Pursuant to the Laws and Rules of the State of Texas, the Texas Constitution, article V, § 18 (providing that commissioners court shall "exercise such powers and jurisdiction over all county business), the Texas Local Government Code, § 291.001 (mandating commissioners court to "maintain the courthouse, offices, and other public buildings"), Section 61.003(a-1) of the Texas Election Code and Texas Secretary of State Election Advisory No. 2017-14,, and the common law granting the County authority to regulate the public health and safety, the Commissioners Court of Starr County finds that it desires to regulate the time, place and manner of electioneering by prohibiting electioneering during any "voting period" as defined by the Texas Election Code in or on property owned or under the care, custody and control of the County of Starr.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT the following policy is adopted:

- The County of Starr, Texas owns various tracts of land located in Starr County, Texas. These tracts of real property serve essential government functions as several government buildings are situated on these properties. These buildings

serve the ever increasing population of Starr County, and include but are not limited to the Starr County Courthouse, Courthouse Annex, County Commissioners' Offices, Justice of the Peace offices, county libraries, fire stations, various other buildings and their associated parking areas that serve to carry on ordinary county business.

- The County of Starr, pursuant to Section 61.003(a-1} of the Texas Election Code and Texas Secretary of State Election Advisory No. 2017-14, desires to regulate the time, place and manner of electioneering by prohibiting electioneering during any "voting period" as defined by the Texas Election Code in or on property owned or under the care, custody and control of the County of Starr in order to prevent or minimize disruptions to the peaceful, ordinary and continuous governmental operations occurring on county property including judicial proceedings involving persons in custody and to further protect the health and safety of residents and pedestrians and to keep sidewalks, driveways, roads and similar areas clear for the egress and ingress of emergency and law enforcement vehicles, pedestrians and motor vehicle traffic in and around county properties as further shown in the areas identified by a red lines in the attached Maps 1-5 which are incorporated herein for all purposes:

- 1. Map of Area commonly known as El Cenizo*
- 2. Map of area commonly known as Courthouse*
- 3. Map of area commonly known as La Rosita Commissioner Pct. #1*
- 4. Map of area commonly known as Starr County Courthouse Annex*
- 5. Map of area commonly known as Zarate Park*

The Starr County Sheriff shall enforce these policies as mandated by Texas Local Government Code, §§ 291.003 ("county sheriff shall have charge and control of the county courthouse, subject to the regulations of the commissioners court") & 292.001 (Commissioners authority for "auxiliary county buildings").


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the Starr County Judge's Office shall place proper notice of no Electioneering on County Property to inform the general public of the restriction or prohibition.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT that any person violating a rule adopted under this order commits an offense, will be prosecuted as a Criminal Trespass which is a Class B misdemeanor, pursuant, punishable by fine not to exceed \$2,000.00 and up to six (6) months in Jail for each violation.


