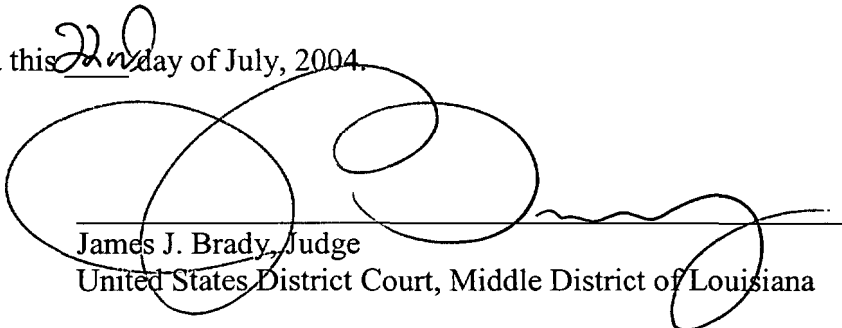
IT IS ORDERED that all claims asserted in these actions relating to Swanson Correctional Center for Youth-Madison Parish Unit are dismissed, with prejudice;
