JUDGMENT IN A CIVIL CASE

JURY VERDICT. This action came before the Court for a trial by jury. The issues have been tried and the jury rendered its verdict.

DECISION BY THE COURT. This action came to trial before the Court on the issues

of back pay, medical expenses, and prospective injunctive relief. The issues have been tried and a decision has been rendered.

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that judgment is entered in favor of EEOC and against Greenville Ford-Mercury, Inc. in the amount of \$14,706 in compensatory damages for emotional harm, \$35,294 in punitive damages, \$526 in back pay and interest, and \$949 in compensation for medical expenses – for a total award of \$51,475.

Greenville Ford-Mercury, Inc. is permanently enjoined from discriminating against any person on the basis of disability and must comply with the permanent injunction described in the Court's August 6, 2002 Order.
