Following submission of the parties' proposed pretrial schedules, this matter came before the Court for a telephone conference call on March 1, 2016 [R. 29], to discuss pretrial deadlines and scheduling. Christopher Wiest and Paul Darpel appeared on behalf of Plaintiffs. Jonathan Salomon, Katherine Crosby, and Abby Green appeared on behalf of Defendants. Although in their motion for summary judgment the Plaintiffs contend that there are no genuine issues of material fact [R. 16], the parties discussed whether discovery should occur in this matter while dispositive motions are pending.
