## **ORDER**

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment as to the EEOC's Claims (docket no. 14) is **DENIED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the EEOC's Motion to Quash the Notice of Deposition of Diane Roberson (docket no. 47) is **GRANTED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant's Motion to Compel Responses to Discovery Requests (docket no. 50) is GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART. The motion is denied with respect to Defendant's second set of discovery requests and interrogatory number 5 directed to the EEOC and request for production number 30 directed to the EEOC in Defendant's first set of discovery requests. The motion is granted with regard to interrogatories 1 and 2 directed to the EEOC, as to which the EEOC shall provide Defendant complete answers stating the amount

of damages and the facts supporting the requested damage amounts. The motion is also granted

with respect to request for production numbers 9-11, 19-21, and 31-33, as to which the EEOC shall

identify the specific documents that are responsive to those requests. Finally, the motion is granted

with regard to Defendant's request for the EEOC's case logs. The EEOC shall provide its

supplemental responses and documents within fourteen (14) days of the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant's Motion for Leave to File Supplemental

Brief in Support of Worth's Motion to Compel Responses to Discovery Requests (docket no. 58) is

**GRANTED**.
