3. Defendants shall, on or before the 15th of each month and commencing on January 15, 1986, produce at plaintiffs' counsel's offices the following documents:

a. All injury to inmate reports for the preceding month.

b. All pages of the clinic log containing entries for the preceding month.

c. All pages of the infraction log containing entries for infractions lodged in the preceding month.

d. All pages of the administrative segregation logbook containing entries made during the preceding month.

e. All forms, documents and other records reflecting the placement of C-76 inmates into protective custody, for all inmates placed in protective custody during the preceding month.

f. All assigned/unassigned reports bearing dates of the preceding month.

4. ~~Defendants shall designate a member of their Central Office staff who will be responsible for ensuring compliance with plaintiffs' discovery requests. The court shall be notified of the designated person's identity.~~

~~Defendants' counsel shall meet with the designated person within five days of the service of any discovery request filed by plaintiffs after the date of this order in order to discuss any problems that may arise in the production of the required materials and any clarifications that may be required as to exactly what is sought.~~
