I am a pro se lawyer on behalf of the descendants of African-American slavery in the United States of America. In America, and throughout the world, Africans were caught, bought, and sold into slavery. They were taken to the United States of America to work as slaves. To be slaves. No pay, miserable conditions and a crime was committed against these people, African-Americans. I am suing the Federal Government, the U.S. Government, The United States of America for \$10 trillion that is at least \$1,000,000,000 per descendant of slave up to 1/24th slave descendant.
