## <u>ORDER</u>

This matter appears before the Court on the State Defendants' Motion to Dismiss Plaintiffs' Complaint (Doc. No. [35]) filed on January 28, 2019.

A review of the record shows that Plaintiffs amended their Complaint after the filing of Defendants' motion. Doc. No. [41].

"Under . . . federal law, an amended complaint supersedes the initial complaint and becomes the operative pleading in the case." <u>Lowery v. Ala.</u>

<u>Power Co.</u>, 483 F.3d 1184, 1219–20 (11th Cir. 2007). Where an amended complaint supersedes the initial complaint, a motion to dismiss as to the initial complaint is rendered moot. <u>See Taylor v. Alabama</u>, 275 F. App'x 836, 838 (11th Cir. 2008)

("Subsequently, [p]laintiffs amended their complaint and Defendants' motion to dismiss became moot.").

Accordingly, the State Defendants' Motion to Dismiss Plaintiffs' Complaint (Doc. No. [35]) is **DEEMED MOOT**.<sup>1</sup>
