ORDER

Pending before the court is Baht Tziyon's third-party motion [Doc. 6] to intervene as a party plaintiff pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 24(a) and motion [Doc. 7] for an extension of time to file her certificate of interested persons ("CIP") and joint planning report ("JPR&DS"). Plaintiff Equal Employment Opportunity Commission ("EEOC") and Defendant Racetrac Petroleum, Inc. ("Racetrac") do not oppose the motions. [Doc. 9 at 2 n. 1].

For good cause shown, the court **GRANTS** the motion [Doc. 6] to intervene and **GRANTS** the motion [Doc. 7] for an extension of time for Tziyon to file her CIP and JPR&DS up to and including **July 26, 2006**. The court will issue a scheduling

order incorporating the information contained in both planning reports.¹
