
Ohio Redistricting Commission, et al.

E N T R Y

This cause originated in this court upon the filing of a complaint invoking this court's original jurisdiction pursuant to Article XI, Section 9 of the Ohio Constitution.

Upon consideration thereof and consistent with the opinion rendered herein, this court declares the General Assembly–district plan invalid. It is ordered by the court that pursuant to Article XI, Section 9(B), the Ohio Redistricting Commission shall be reconstituted under Article XI, Section 1, to convene, and to ascertain and adopt a General Assembly–district plan in conformity with the Ohio Constitution. It is further ordered that the Ohio Redistricting Commission shall adopt a new plan within ten days of this judgment. It is further ordered that this court retains jurisdiction for the purpose of reviewing the new plan adopted by the Ohio Redistricting Commission. It is further ordered that petitioners shall file any objections to the new plan within three days of the plan's adoption. Costs assessed to respondents.
