
**ORDER STAYING THE CASE, VACATING THE TRIAL,
AND VACATING ALL PRE-TRIAL DATES**

1 Upon review of the parties' Joint Stipulation for an Order Staying the Case,
2 Vacating the Trial, and Vacating all Pre-Trial Dates, and finding good cause
3 therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 4 1. All deadlines in the Order Granting Joint Stipulation to Amend Civil
5 Trial Scheduling Order and Stay Discovery, Dkt. 183, are vacated.
- 6 2. The matter is stayed in its entirety unless and until the parties return to
7 the Court to request a resumption of the lawsuit and to seek a further
8 order governing the timing of the case.
- 9 3. The parties shall submit a Joint Status Report to this Court by February
10 1, 2021, advising the Court as to the status of settlement negotiations.
11 The parties will further submit Joint Status Reports every 60 days
12 thereafter until the parties have reached a settlement agreement and have
13 submitted it to the Court for approval, if necessary. In the alternative,
14 the parties will return to the Court to request a resumption of the lawsuit
15 and to seek a further order governing the timing of the case.
