**STIPULATED MOTION TO STAY  
ACTION AND REFER TO  
SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE JUDGE**

*(Assigned to the Hon. Scott H. Rash)*

Plaintiff Kathleen Hoffard (“Plaintiff”), and Defendants Cochise County and Lisa Marra, in her official capacity as Cochise County Elections Director (“Defendants”) (collectively, the “Parties”) hereby file this *Stipulated Motion to Stay Action and Refer to Settlement Conference Judge* for this Court’s approval.

The Parties are engaged in serious settlement discussions and believe that the action may be resolved with the assistance of a settlement conference judge. Cochise County has announced that it will be offering curbside voting as a reasonable modification for voters with disabilities in the upcoming general election, and the Parties wish to meet with a settlement conference judge to reach agreement on remaining relief and finalize a

1 resolution to this action. The parties agree that a successful settlement conference of this  
2 action would require that no further activity occur in the case.

3 The Parties prefer to be assigned to either Magistrate Bruce G. Macdonald or  
4 Magistrate Thomas D. Ferraro for resolution, calendars permitting. The parties are  
5 comparing calendars and will provide this Court with their mutual availability for a  
6 settlement conference via email to Chambers this week.

7 Accordingly, the parties respectfully move that this action be stayed for 65 days,  
8 pending this Court's referral of this action to either Magistrate Macdonald or Magistrate  
9 Ferraro, calendars permitting.
