

ORDER

PASSAIC COUNTY BOARD OF FREEHOLDERS: AND MARTIN BARNES, DIRECTOR OF THE PASSAIC COUNTY YOUTH CENTER:





This matter having been opened before the Court on October 19, 1978, William Bizub appearing for the office of the Public Defender, Deputy Attorney General Elaine Ballai appearing for the State of New Jersey, Leo Gellene appearing for the defendants and Passaic County Prosecutor Burrell Ives Humphreys appearing as amicus curiae, it is on this 19th day of October 1978 ordered as follows:

- 1. Space shall be made available in the Preakness Hospital area to receive juveniles who can not be housed in the Passaic County Juvenile Detention Center because of overcrowding.
- 2. The Board of Chosen Freeholders shall provide the necessary personnel to supervise the juveniles and maintain security at the Preakness Hospital area during their detention.
- 3. The Board of Freeholders shall forthwith meet with and consult with representatives of the Department of Corrections as to physical violations of health and safety standards at any facility in Passaic County in which juveniles are housed, whether it be the Juvenile Detention Center or the Preakness Hospital area, and make prompt and reasonable efforts to correct violations of such standards.
- 4. The Board of Freeholders shall expedite their efforts to construct a new Juvenile Detention Center in consultation with

the Director of the Youth Center and representatives of the Department of Corrections.

5. The date of November 14, 1978 at 10:a.m. be hereby set for the Court to review the progress made under these rules and to make this order more specific if so required at that time.
