

O R D E R

Upon consideration of plaintiff's Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order, and it appearing that plaintiff and the class he represents will suffer irreparable injury to their rights under the First and Fourteenth amendments to the United States Constitution unless temporary relief is granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that defendants are enjoined from enforcing ordinances 754 and 755 enacted by the City Council of Bogalusa on July 7, 1967, *and these ordinances are stayed in toto, (7DRN)* pending a determination of plaintiff's motion for injunctive relief.

This order will become effective upon plaintiff's posting security in the amount of \$100.00 and upon actual notice thereof to the defendants.
