MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

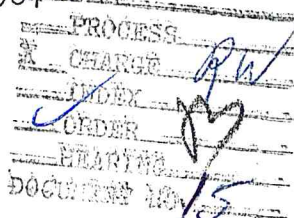
