Petitioner Board of Education of the City of New York filed this petition for a writ of mandamus and a motion for a temporary stay of a district court temporary restraining order pending determination of the petition. By order dated February 17, 2012, the Court denied the temporary stay and in its February 21, 2012 order regarding the denial of the temporary stay, the Court stated that it was taking “no action at this time on the petition for mandamus”.
