1	This Court HEREBY ORDERS that the temporary restraining order shall be extended a further		
2	ten days, through 11:59 PM on February 27, 2025. During that time, the City of Grants Pass		
3	SHALL NOT take any action to enforce the following provision of the Grants Pass Municipal		
4	Code: Grants Pass City Code 5.61.010; Grants Pass City Code 5.61.030; Grants Pass City Code		
5	5.61.050; Grants Pass City Code 5.61.070.

7	During that time, this Court FURTHER ORDERS that the City of Grants Pass shall not cite,		
8	arrest, detain, issue fines, or otherwise prosecute any person for camping anywhere in the city,		
9	nor shall the City compel a person to leave a campsite, remove a campsite (other than one		
10	obviously abandoned for multiple days), or otherwise prohibit a person from camping on lands		
11	designated as park spaces.

13	This Court FURTHER ORDERS that, notwithstanding the above terms, this order does not		
14	impair the city of Grants Pass 1) in its enforcement of Grants Pass 5.61.020, nor 2) in its actions		
15	to compel a person to leave a campsite, to remove a campsite, or otherwise to prohibit a person		
16	from camping in Riverside Park, 304 East Park Street, or Reinhardt Volunteer Park, 1690		
17	Southwest Webster Road.
