[PROPOSED] ORDER **GRANTING PLAINTIFFS'** EMERGENCY MOTION FOR **TEMPORARY RESTRAINING** ORDER AND PRELIMINARY INJUCTION ON BEHALF OF PLAINTIFF O.C.G.
