- B. Vacate the Department of Education's February 14, 2025 Dear Colleague Letter, End DEI Portal, Frequently Asked Questions About Racial Preferences and Stereotypes Under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act, and April 3, 2025 Certification Requirement, or

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in the alternative, permanently restrain or enjoin Defendants and their agents,

employees or representatives, successors, and any other person acting directly or

indirectly in concert with them, from enforcing and/or implementing the Dear

Colleague Letter or Certification Requirement; and

C. Grant any other relief that is just or equitable.

Pursuant to Local Rule 7.1(d), Plaintiffs respectfully request oral argument given the

importance of the issues presented in this Motion.
