**VERIFIED COMPLAINT FOR  
DECLARATORY JUDGMENT AND INJUNCTIVE RELIEF**

NOW COME Plaintiffs Darin Whitten, Lisa C. Kaiser, William D. Kaiser, Dorothy Taft, and Jared Kerwin, by and through their attorneys, and complain for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief, stating as follows:

**INTRODUCTION**

1. This case involves the conduct of a caucus by the Rochester Township Republican Central Committee to nominate candidates on behalf of the party for the April 6, 2021 consolidated election.

2. Because of the way the caucus was conducted the Plaintiffs' constitutional rights under the First and Fourteenth Amendment to the U. S. Constitution and Article III, Sections 3 and 4 of the Illinois Constitution were violated. As such, they bring this action for declaratory and injunctive relief pursuant to 42 U.S.C. Sec. 1983 and Illinois law.

#### **JURISDICTION**

3. Subject matter jurisdiction is established pursuant to 28 U.S.C. Sec. 1331 and 1343, as well as 42 U.S.C. Sec. 1983, and pendant jurisdiction.

4. This Court has personal jurisdiction over the parties and venue is proper as all parties reside and all substantive events complained of occurred in Sangamon County, Illinois

#### **THE PARTIES**

5. The Plaintiff, Darin Whitten, at all times relevant, was a registered voter in Rochester Township, Illinois; was a qualified participant attending the Rochester Township Republican Caucus on December 1, 2020; voted in said Caucus (hereinafter "Caucus"); and was nominated at said Caucus to be the Republican candidate for Rochester Township Highway Commissioner. (60 ILCS 1/45-50(a)).

6. The Plaintiffs, Lisa C. Kaiser, William D. Kaiser, Dorothy Taft, and Jared Kerwin, at all times relevant, were registered voters in Rochester Township, Illinois; were qualified participants attending the Rochester Township Republican Caucus on December 1, 2020; and voted in said Caucus. (60 ILCS 1/45-50(a))

7. The Defendant Rochester Township Republican Central Committee, at all times relevant, is a township central committee, as defined by Section 45-15 of the Illinois Township Code (60 ILCS 1/45-15) that makes nominations for township candidates for the Republican

Party, which is an “established political party” in Rochester Township, as defined under Section 10-2 of the Illinois Election Code (10 ILCS 5/10-2).

8. The Defendants, Thomas K. Munroe, Mark C. White, Anthony Saputo, Matthew Butcher, and David Armstrong, at all times relevant, were and are the duly elected or appointed Rochester Township Republican Precinct Committeepersons: and together constitute the Rochester Township Republican Central Committee. (60 ILCS 1/45-15).

9. The Defendant, Thomas K. Munroe, also served as the Caucus Chairman or Presiding Officer for the December 1, 2020 Rochester Township Republican Caucus, hereinafter sometimes referred to as: “Caucus”. (Rochester Township Republican Caucus December 1, 2020 Minutes, attached hereto as Exhibit “A”).

10. The Defendant Lynn Chard, at all times relevant, was and is the duly elected Rochester Township Clerk, whose duties included accepting from the Chairman of the Rochester Township Republican Central Committee nomination papers, stating who was nominated by the Caucus for each Township office to be elected at the April 6, 2021 Consolidated Election, as provided in in Section 45-20 of the Township Code. (60 ILCS 1/45-20(b)).

11. The Defendant, Lynn Chard, also served as the Secretary of the Caucus. (Exhibit “A”).

12. The Defendant, Don Gray, at all times relevant was and is the duly elected Clerk of Sangamon County, Illinois, whose duties include accepting from the Rochester Township Clerk not less than 68 days before the township election ( by January 28, 2021) the Township Clerk’s certification of the candidates nominated at the Caucus. (10 ILCS 5/2A-16 and 60 ILCS 1/45-20(c)).

13. The Defendant, Darrell Maxheimer, at all times relevant was and is the duly elected Road Commissioner of Rochester Township; the purported winner of the Caucus vote for the Republican nomination for Road Commissioner; and whose name was certified to the Township Clerk by the Caucus' Presiding Officer, Thomas K. Munroe, as the person nominated by the Caucus to be the Republican Party candidate for Road Commissioner at the Consolidated Election to be held on April 6, 2021.

## FACTS

14. Pursuant to 60 ILCS 1/45-10, Notice of the Rochester Township Republican Party Caucus to be held December 1, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. at the Rochester Township Hall was published in the November 19, 2020 *Rochester Times*, and a copy of said Notice is attached hereto as Exhibit "B".

15. The Rochester Township Democratic Central Committee did not hold a caucus December 1, 2020, and no candidates filed for to run as independents or as new political party candidates for any Rochester Township office in the 2021 election, so being nominated by the Republican caucus is tantamount to being elected, absent a successful write-in candidate.

16. Pursuant to Section 45-15 of the Illinois Township Code (60 ILCS 1/45-15), the Rochester Township Republican Central Committee (hereafter sometimes referred to as: "Committee") was mandated to, prior to said Caucus, promulgate rules of procedure for said Caucus.

17. On information and belief, the Committee failed to promulgate such rules of procedure, in clear violation of this provision of the Township Code and due process.

18. On information and belief, the Committee, or one or more members of the Committee, caused ballots to be printed prior the Caucus, so prior to any candidate even being nominated

19. Said ballots listed the name of each township office up for election in the April 6, 2020 Consolidated Election, and below each office, the name of only the incumbent office-holder occupying said office, to wit:

a. SUPERVISOR:	Mark Poffenberger
b. CLERK:	Lynn Chard
c. ROAD COMMISSIONER:	Darrell Maxheimer
d. ASSESSOR:	Anjanetter (Anjie) Lord
e. TRUSTEES:	Bill DeCroix Thomas Hendrickson Tim Antonacci Rodney Vose

20. The ballot instructed voters to “CIRCLE A NAME OR WRITE IN CANDIDATE”, and included a blank line below the incumbent office-holder’s name. (A copy of said ballot is attached hereto as Exhibit “C”).

21. 115 persons signed Affidavits Of Voters Attending Township Caucus, and a copy of said Affidavits is attached hereto as Exhibit “D”.

22. Twenty-two of said 115 signers, or 19.1 per cent, did not attend the Caucus inside the Rochester Township Hall.

23. Those signers who did not attend the Caucus inside the Hall, drove in motor vehicles to the parking lot of said Hall.

24 Said signers were approached by persons, who were or purported to be Caucus Judges, and asked if they wanted a ballot.

25. When the signers said they wanted a ballot, the Caucus Judges gave them the Affidavit of Voters Attending Township Caucus to sign, and then took the signed Affidavits inside the Hall, got ballots, and brought the ballots out to the signers.

26. The signers then voted their ballots and gave them back to the Caucus Judges, who took them back inside the Hall.

27. All of the signers who voted outside, cast their votes prior to the start of the Caucus, at 7:15 p.m. (See Affidavits of Caucus Participants and Co-Plaintiffs, Jared Kerwin, Lisa C. Kaiser and Dorothy Taft, attached hereto as Exhibits "E", "F" and "G", and Caucus Minutes, Exhibit "A".)

28. The last ballots cast outside were brought inside when the caucus meeting started at 7:15 p.m., and were deposited in an orange bucket on the table in the front of the caucus room.

29. Thus, almost 20 per cent of the votes were cast prior to any of the candidates being nominated.

30. Voting before candidates are nominated is not only contrary to due process, and all rules of parliamentary procedure, it is also contrary to the rules set forth in *Township Caucus Guide For 2021* (hereinafter: *Guide*), issued by the Illinois State Board of Elections (<https://www.toi.org/Resources/68832451-8c0f-4ca7-b59f-49b90c302841/2021%20Township%20Caucus%20Guide.pdf>).

31. The *Guide* sets forth the following steps that should be taken at a caucus in the order set forth below:

- a. sign affidavit;
- b. chairman of township party central committee calls meeting to order;
- c. caucus participants elect a secretary;

d. rules of procedure drafted by the central committee are approved or amended;

e. chairman announces the method of voting selected by the central committee;

f. chairman announces offices for which nominees are to be chosen.

g. chairman calls for opening nominations for each office;

h. either vote on nominations for each office after nominations for that office closes; or vote after the closing of nominations for all offices;

(*Guide*, pages 9 & 10).

32. Section 45-50 of the Township Code mandates that rules of procedure for conducting a township caucus must be approved and may be amended by a majority vote of the qualified participants attending the caucus. (60 ILCS 1/45-50(a)).

33. The instant Caucus failed to approve or amend rules of procedure for conducting a township caucus. (See Exhibit "A".)

34. The only candidates nominated for Township Road Commissioner at the Caucus were Plaintiff Darin Whitten, and Defendant Darrell Maxheimer, but only Maxheimer's name was printed on the ballot.

35. A count of the 115 votes cast shows that in the race for the nomination for Road Commissioner, Darrell Maxheimer had either 1, 2 or 3 more votes than Darin Whitten, depending on how a ballot is counted, on which the voter wrote in Darin Whitten's name and circled Darrell Maxheimer's name, i.e. whether it is counted for Whitten; counted for Maxheimer or not counted. (A copy of said 115 ballots is attached hereto as Exhibit "H".)

36. Subsequent thereto Defendant Thomas K. Munroe filed with Defendant Township Clerk Lynn Chard a Certificate Of Nomination By Caucus, showing Darrell Maxheimer as the

Republican candidate for Road Commissioner. ( A copy of said Certificate is attached hereto as Exhibit "I".)

37. On December 23, 2020, the Plaintiffs filed a Complaint For Declaratory Judgment And Injunctive Relief, and an Emergency Motion for Temporary Restraining Order & Preliminary Injunction in the Sangamon County Circuit Court under case no. 2020CH00201.

38. On January 5, 2021 the Circuit Court dismissed the Plaintiffs' state court case because the Court concluded it lacked subject matter jurisdiction, and therefore is not a decision on the merits, and is not *res judicata*.

39. On January 7, 2021 the Plaintiffs filed a Notice Of Appeal from the State Court action under appeal no. 4-21-0018, and a motion to expedite the appeal, but said motion has not yet been decided.

40. While the Illinois Election Code permits the filing of objections before a local electoral board and the decisions of that electoral board can be appealed via administrative review to the Circuit Court of Sangamon County, the Rochester Township Republican Central Committee can simply fill a vacancy created by the removal from the ballot through its appointment power, and appoint the same person who was removed.

41. Further, the electoral board does not have the power to order a candidate's name on the ballot if the candidate's name was not on the Certificate Of Nomination By Caucus; it only has the power to remove or not remove from the ballot a candidate whose name was on the Certificate Of Nomination By Caucus.

42. Moreover, the electoral board process was created to address the qualifications and nomination papers of those nominated to hold office; not to address constitutional flaws in the

caucus process that nominated them, resulting in the deprivation of constitutional and other rights.

43. According to the Illinois State Board Of Elections website:

- a. 2/19/21 is the last day for the election authority to have a sufficient number of ballots for mailing to certain voters in the U.S. Military and outside the United States (10 ILCS 5/16-5.01);
- b. 2/25/21 is the first day to mail ballots to voters in the U.S. who have made application therefor (10 ILCS 5/19-4); and
- c. 2/25/21 is the first day for early voting (10 ILCS 5/19A-15 and 19A-20).

#### **COUNT I – DECLARATORY AND INJUNCTIVE RELIEF UNDER 10 ILCS 5/29-1**

44.. Plaintiffs incorporates by reference, as though fully set forth herein, the allegations contained in Paragraphs 1 through 42 of this complaint.

45. The Illinois Appellate Court has ruled that “The caucus is the equivalent of a primary election.” *Lenehan v. Twp. Officers Electoral Bd. of Schaumburg Twp.*, 2013 IL App (1st) 130619 ¶45, 988 N.E.2d 1003, 1015, 370 Ill.Dec. 647, 659 (Ill. App. 2013).

46. As such, this action is more akin to an election contest action than a ballot challenge action.

47. Under Article III, Section 3 of the Illinois Constitution, “All elections shall be free and equal.”

48. Under Article III, Section 4 of the Illinois Constitution, “The General Assembly by law shall [...] insure [...] the integrity of the election process.”

49. 10 ILCS 5/29-17 of the Illinois Election Code states that:

Any person who subjects, or causes to be subjected, a citizen of the State of Illinois or other person within the jurisdiction thereof to the deprivation of any rights, privileges, or immunities secured by the Constitution or laws of the United States or of the State of Illinois, relating to registration to vote, the conduct of elections, voting, or the nomination or election of candidates for public or political party office, shall be liable to the party injured or any person affected, in any action or proceeding for redress.

50. The Appellate Court had ruled against plaintiffs seeking to set aside a caucus in *Ferguson v. Ryan*, stating that “the minor and technical violations of the statute...did not affect the overall fairness of the caucus and in no way prejudiced the outcome.” It then held that “They (plaintiffs) have not shown that any of the violations were caused by fraud or affected the outcome of the caucus.” 623 N.E.2d 1004, 1008-9, 251 Ill.App.3d 1042, 1048 (Ill. App. 1993). In the present case, however, because of the closeness of the vote for the nomination for Road Commissioner and the egregiousness of the violations (including having one candidate’s name printed on the ballot pre-caucus and pre-nomination while the other’s name had to be written in, and allowing votes to be cast before any candidates were nominated, and voters even knew who was running!), the overall fairness of the caucus has been affected, and the outcome was prejudiced and would have more likely than not have been different had legally and constitutionally proper procedures been followed. Further, the violations here were not minor and technical.

51. The December 1, 2020, Rochester Township Republican Party Caucus, which was the equivalent of a primary election, was not free and equal, and the integrity of the election process was not insured. The rules for Township Caucuses set forth in the Township Code were egregiously violated, as were the procedures set forth in the *Township Caucus Guide*. As a result, Darin Whitten, a citizen of the State of Illinois, was subjected to deprivations of his “rights, privileges, or immunities secured by the Constitution or laws of the United States or of the State of Illinois, relating to the conduct of elections, voting, or the nomination or election of candidates for public or political party office.” Additionally, Plaintiffs Lisa C. Kaiser, William D. Kaiser, Dorothy Taft, and Jared Kerwin, as caucus participants and supporters of Darin Whitten were deprived of their right to a free and equal election as voters. This is because:

- A. Rules of Procedure were not adopted, as required by the Township Code
- B. Voting was allowed by outdoor “curbside voters” before the 7:15 p.m. start time of the Caucus set forth in the Caucus Minutes, and before any candidates were nominated.
- C. The name of Darrell Maxheimer was pre-printed on the ballot (before any nominations were taken) while caucus voters had to write in Darin Whitten’s name to vote for him for Road Commissioner. The election for Road Commissioner was therefore not free and equal and not conducted according to the Illinois Township Code because one nominated candidate had the privilege of having his name printed on the ballot while the other had to have his name written in by the Township Caucus voters.

WHEREAS, Plaintiffs request that this Court:

- I. Declare that the December 1, 2020, Rochester Township Republican Party Caucus was invalid and void regarding its nomination for the office of Road Commissioner due to its having violated the Illinois Township Code and the Illinois and U.S. Constitutions.
- II. Issue a temporary restraining order, followed by preliminary and permanent injunctions, against Defendants and all those acting in concert, a) enjoining the Rochester Township Clerk and Sangamon County Clerk from certifying Darrell Maxheimer as the Republican Candidate for Rochester Township Road Commissioner at the April 6, 2021 Election or printing his name on said ballot as a candidate for said office; and b) ordering the Rochester Township Republican Central Committee to: hold a second Republican Caucus for the purpose of

nominating a candidate for Road Commissioner that complies with the Township Code and the U.S. and Illinois Constitutions; **or in the alternative**, a re-vote for 1 or 2 hours on a week-day evening, where voters could come to the Township Hall and cast a secret paper ballot containing the names of Maxheimer and Whitten for the Republican nomination for Road Commissioner

- III. Award to Plaintiffs reasonable costs, expenses, and attorney fees.
- IV. Award such other and further relief as this Court shall deem just and reasonable.

## **COUNT II – DECLARATORY AND INJUNCTIVE RELIEF UNDER 42 U.S.C. §1983**

52. Plaintiffs incorporates by reference, as though fully set forth herein, the allegations contained in Paragraphs 1 through 51 of this complaint.

53. The United States Constitution's Equal Protection Clause, U.S. Const. amend. XIV, § 1, provides that no State shall "deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the laws."

54. The First Amendment of the United States Constitution protects the Freedom of Association, and this right has been extended to State actions by the Fourteenth Amendment. The US Supreme Court has said that restrictions on access to the ballot burden two distinct and fundamental rights, "the right of individuals to associate for the advancement of political beliefs, and the right of qualified voters, regardless of their political persuasion, to cast their votes effectively." *Williams v. Rhodes*, 393 U.S. 23, 30 (1968)

55. *Rhodes* further held that "Both of these rights...rank among our most precious freedoms." *id.*

56. 42 U.S.C. §1983 provides that:

Every person who, under color of any statute, ordinance, regulation, custom, or usage, of any State or Territory or the District of Columbia, subjects, or causes to be subjected, any citizen of the United States or other person within the jurisdiction thereof to the deprivation of any rights, privileges, or immunities secured by the Constitution and laws, shall be liable to the party injured in an action at law, suit in equity, or other proper proceeding for redress

57. Because the caucus is authorized by Article 45 of the Township Code (60 ILCS 1/45-5 et seq.); “The costs of caucus elections shall be borne by the township” (65 ILCS 1/45-45); and “The caucus is the equivalent of a primary election” (*Lenehan.*, 2013 IL App (1st) 130619 at ¶45), the caucus was clearly under color of law.

58. Plaintiff Whitten’s Equal Protection rights were deprived because his opponent’s name was pre-printed on the ballot, while his name had to be written in, and because voting occurred prior to the taking of nominations, and he was therefore treated differently than his opponent without any rational basis, and said differential treatment was extremely adverse to Plaintiff Whitten.

59. As this Court stated in its May 1, 2020 Order: “placing candidates on the ballot...implicates unique constitutional concerns.” *Bambenek v. White*, U.S. Dist. Ct., Central Dist, IL No. 3:20-cv-3107, p. 5.

60. The 1<sup>st</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment rights to vote and right of association of Plaintiffs were violated because they were inhibited from voting for the Candidate of their choosing by being presented a ballot with one name pre-printed and the other having to be written in.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs request that this Court:

I. Declare that the December 1, 2020, Rochester Township Republican Party Caucus was invalid and void regarding the nomination for the office of Road

Commissioner due to its having violated the First and Fourteenth Amendment rights of the Plaintiffs.

- II. Issue a temporary restraining order, followed by preliminary and permanent injunctions, against Defendants and all those acting in concert, **a)** enjoining the Rochester Township Clerk and Sangamon County Clerk from certifying Darrell Maxheimer as the Republican Candidate for Rochester Township Road Commissioner at the April 6, 2021 Election or printing his name on said ballot as a candidate for said office; and **b)** ordering the Rochester Township Republican Central Committee to hold a second Republican Caucus for the purpose of nominating a candidate for Road Commissioner that complies with the U.S. and Illinois Constitutions and the Illinois Township Code, **or in the alternative**, a re-vote for 1 or 2 hours on a week-day evening, where voters could come to Township Hall and cast a secret paper ballot containing the names of Maxheimer and Whitten for the Republican nomination for Road Commissioner.
- III. Award to Plaintiffs reasonable costs, expenses, and attorney fees.
- IV. Award such other and further relief as this Court shall deem just and reasonable.

#### **PRAYER FOR RELIEF**

WHEREAS, PLAINTIFFS accordingly and respectfully demand that judgment be entered in their favor and against Defendants as follows:

- I. Declare that the December 1, 2020, Rochester Township Republican Party Caucus was invalid and void regarding its nomination for the office of Road Commissioner.

- II. Issue a temporary restraining order, followed by preliminary and permanent injunctions, against Defendants and all those acting in concert, **a)** enjoining the Rochester Township Clerk and Sangamon County Clerk from certifying Darrell Maxheimer as the Republican Candidate for Rochester Township Road Commissioner at the April 6, 2021 Election or printing his name on said ballot as a candidate for said office; and **b)** ordering the Rochester Township Republican Central Committee to hold a second Republican Caucus for the purpose of nominating a candidate for Road Commissioner that complies with the U.S. and Illinois Constitutions and the Illinois Township Code, **or in the alternative**, a re-vote for 1 or 2 hours on a week-day evening, where voters could come to the Township Hall and cast a secret paper ballot containing the names of Maxheimer and Whitten for the Republican nomination for Road Commissioner.
- III. Award to Plaintiffs reasonable costs, expenses, and attorney fees.
- IV. Award such other and further relief as this Court shall deem just and reasonable.



Nomination for Trustee was made by Nancy Poffenberger and was seconded for Rodney Vose.

Mark Poffenberger made the motion to close the nomination and Cole Taft seconded the motion.

Ballots were cast and counted. Monroe read the results. Candidates for the Consolidated Election are as follows:

Supervisor - Mark Poffenberger

Clerk - Bryan Chard

Highway Commissioner - Darrell Mathewson

Assessor - Angie Lord

Trustee - Bill DeCroz, Rodney Vose, Tom Hendrickson, and Tim Antonacci

There being no further business, Tom Monroe closed the Caucus at 7:45 P.M.
