ORDER

The parties are instructed that all future filings in any reassigned case are to bear the initials of the newly assigned judge immediately after the case number. The issue of consolidation is not before the Court. **The Court maintains the briefing schedule set by Judge Orrick for Defendant's opposition but notes would urge Defendant to file earlier if possible. The parties shall appear for a hearing on the TRO at 9:00 a.m. on April 25, 2025. Plaintiff may file a reply by 8:00 a.m. on April 25, 2025 or may reply during oral argument.**
